Outgoing MSCA and HFSP fellows:

Objective:

To stimulate those who have not yet been mobile out of Norway

Requirements:

- The fellow must have spent at least 5 of the previous 8 years in Norway
- Master (DN) or PhD (PF and HFSP) from Norwegian institution

Incoming HFSP fellows:

Objective: Encourage Norwegian institutions to host HFSP fellows
